Full membership

Corporate membership

Senior membership

If you're over 65 and retired then you can get a senior membership. This gives you all the benefits of Koru at a reduced rate.

Annual guest membership

With any Koru membership you can purchase an Annual Guest Card, which you can use to invite a guest to join you in the lounge if there's space available. They just need to be travelling later that day on an Air New Zealand operated flight.

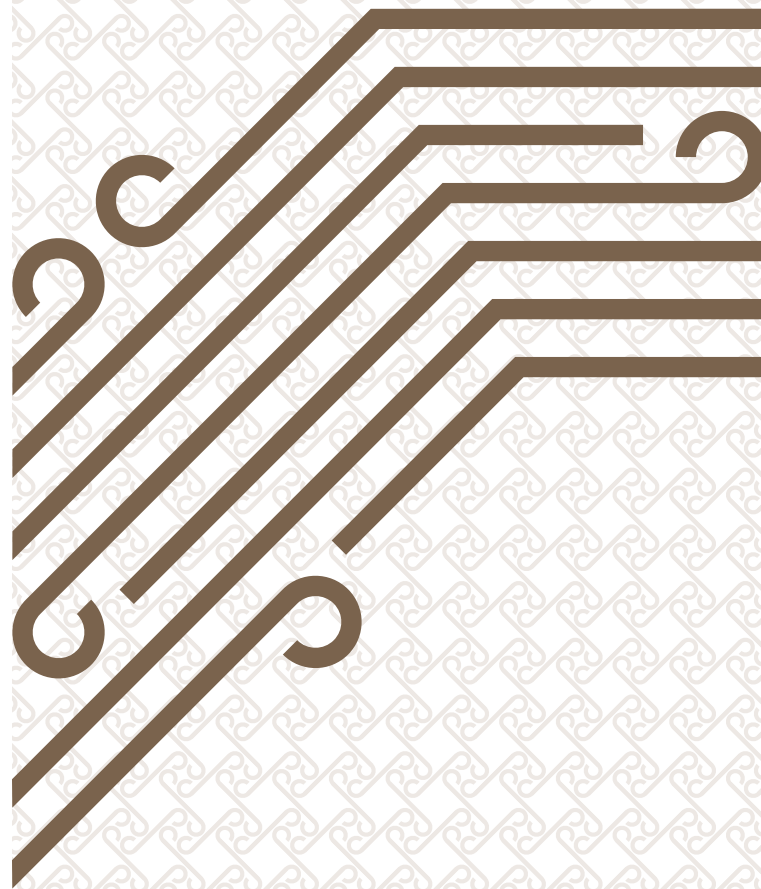

TERMS & CONDITIONS

To become a Member, an application must be made to Air New Zealand by presentation of a completed application form and payment of the prescribed non-refundable Application and Membership Fee for the term of membership specified.

Membership is at the discretion of Air New Zealand, which may accept or reject an application for Membership as it deems fit.

Members may hold only one type of Koru Membership of at any time.

Renewal of Membership is due upon the anniversary of the Member's date of joining. Membership can be renewed for either a twelve (12) or twenty-four (24) month period. Unless a Membership is renewed within three (3) months of its expiry it will be cancelled and any subsequent application for its renewal will be subject to payment of the then applicable application fee.

"Koru Lounges" are the lounges provided by Air New Zealand for Member's use prior to the Member and their guest(s) boarding an Air New Zealand flight at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin domestic airport terminals.

"Koru Regional Lounges" are the lounges provided by Air New Zealand for Member's use prior to the Member boarding an Air New Zealand flight at Hamilton, Palmerston North, Napier, New Plymouth, Nelson, Queenstown and Invercargill domestic airport terminals.

"International Lounges" are certain lounges within airport terminals, either within New Zealand or internationally, to which Members are permitted access when departing that day on an Air New Zealand ticked and operated flight from such terminals.

The Koru is the Air New Zealand domestic and international air travellers' club and under no circumstances are Membership and/or the conditions thereof interchangeable with or transferable to the Air New Zealand Airpoints programme or any other club or programme operated by Air New Zealand or its partner airlines.

Koru Membership does not give access or rights to the benefits of any other Air New Zealand club or facility unless so stated in the conditions of membership of such other club or facility.

The Membership Card is valid for use by the Member during the period indicated on it provided the applicable Membership Fee has been paid and there has been no termination or revocation of the Member's Membership.

Access to Privileges by a Member travelling on an Air New Zealand codeshare service or joint service which is operated by an alliance partner airline is subject to the conditions imposed by that partner airline.

A guest of a Member will be admitted to the Koru Lounges at domestic airport terminals at Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Dunedin and at Air New Zealand International Lounges when accompanied by the Member and upon surrender of a Guest Pass or presentation of a Guest Card (valid for one Guest). Both the Member and the guest must also present their valid boarding passes for same day travel on an Air New Zealand ticketed and operated flight departing from that Airport or airport terminal. Guest admission is subject to Lounge accommodation at any one time as determined by Air New Zealand in its sole discretion. Member information is collected and used to enable the functioning of Koru and the provision of Privileges thereunder to Members by Air New Zealand. Air New Zealand respects Members' rights of privacy and protects the personal information provided to Air New Zealand by Members for the purposes of their Membership (**"Member Information"**).

Members have the right of access to the information about them held on the Air New Zealand database upon request, on reasonable notice and to have it updated or corrected as necessary.

Air New Zealand has no responsibility for any tax liabilities or other levies or duties that may be imposed on any Member arising from their Koru Membership. Air New Zealand gives no warranty or assurance in relation to such tax liabilities or other levies or duties or the tax-deductibility of the Membership Fee.
