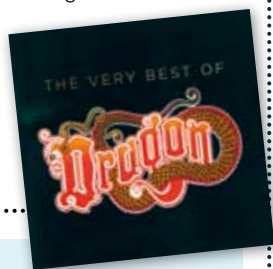
FEATURED TITLE

DRAGON

On Saturday nights in most Kiwi pubs it's safe to assume you'll hear the beloved Dragon classic "April Sun in Cuba". Dragon formed in New Zealand in 1972, but it was only after they relocated to Sydney in 1975 that they really achieved rock-star status both here and in Australia, with hit songs such as "Are You Old Enough" and "Still in Love with You".

Over the years the band has had 40 different members, but has managed to

maintain a consistent sound. This "best of" album features tracks recorded between 1977 and 1990. This year, the band returned to New Zealand to play in a series of concerts, with original band member Todd Hunter replacing his brother Marc as frontman after Marc's death from cancer in 1998.



Glee

This EP from the hit TV programme *Glee* features seven covers of Madonna songs from the "The Power of Madonna" episode. Madonna's music lends itself well to the theatrical show-choir style – the female cast members' cover of "Express Yourself" would make the Queen of Pop proud, and Jane Lynch's rendition of 90s anthem "Vogue" (with alternative lyrics) is genius.



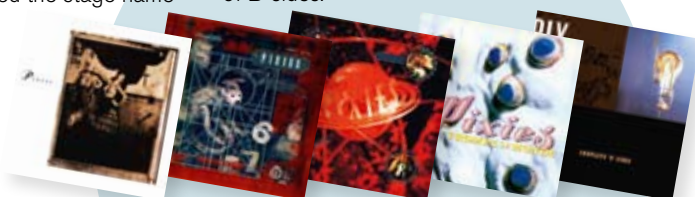
Paul Weller

From his early work with punk band The Jam, to his funkier outings with The Style Council and his experimental solo work, Paul Weller is one of Britain's most influential rock artists. His 10th solo studio album includes contributions from ex-The Jam bass player Bruce Foxton and My Bloody Valentine's Kevin Shields, and proves that Weller still knows how to make great music. Catch him in concert in New Zealand in October.

SPOTLIGHT: PIXIES

When Charles Thompson dropped out of college in the late 80s, he gave himself two choices: either go to New Zealand to see Halley's Comet or form a band. Thompson chose the latter and adopted the stage name Black Francis to become the frontman of the pioneer alternative band, Pixies. Earlier this year Francis and the rest of the band did make it to New

Zealand to perform in two sell-out concerts, which celebrated the 20th anniversary of their popular album *Doolittle*. We have all four Pixies albums on board, plus an album of B-sides.



Dane Rumble

Kiwi pop artist Dane Rumble is something of a curiosity. This year the former member of hip-hop band Fast Crew swapped his trademark baseball cap for a pair of oversized 80s sunglasses and made a radical musical shift to electro-pop. His aptly named album *The Experiment* is a collection of catchy pop songs – a brave change from the rock and hip-hop music that dominates the Kiwi music industry. The risk has paid off, Rumble has earned a loyal fan base, and three of the album's singles, "Always Be Here", "Don't Know What to Do" and "Cruel" have gone gold. Rumble's songs feature both tender vocals and rap, and incorporate many different musical styles – with hints of his hip-hop roots on "Gonna Be Mine", a dash of funk on "Let You Down" and sugary electronica on "Cruel". It's a surprisingly refreshing combination.

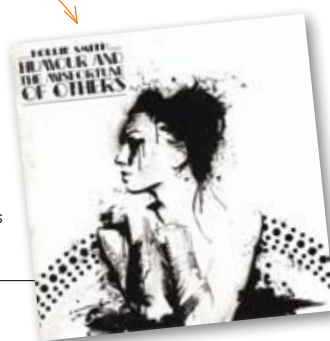
