LADY GAGA

With her crazy antics, eccentric costumes and catchy original tunes, the world of pop music is a much more interesting place since the arrival of Lady Gaga. When the pop diva first toured New Zealand in May 2009 it was as the opening act for burlesque pop troop the Pussycat Dolls. During her 40-minute set, she outshone the Dolls, wowing the audience with her piano playing, vocal talent and stage performance.

Since then, Lady Gaga (who writes her own material) has won a Grammy for best

Electronic/Dance album, for her debut *The Fame*, and is returning to New Zealand for two Auckland concerts this month.

Her second album, *The Fame Monster*, includes the re-release of tracks from her debut album as well as eight new tracks including the dynamic hit "Bad Romance", Euro-pop single "Alejandro" and catchy "Telephone" featuring Beyoncé.



Dave Dobbyn

Kiwi music icon Dave Dobbyn celebrates his prolific music career with the album *Beside You: 30 Years of Hits*. The 39-track album is designed to replicate a live set. The first 20 songs are Kiwi anthems like "Slice of Heaven", "You Oughta Be in Love" and "Loyal" while the other 19 tracks include beauties such as "Don't Hold Your Breath" from his less-well-known album *Lament for the Numb*.



Vampire Weekend

Alternative band Vampire Weekend proved they're more than one-album wonders when their second album *Contra* reached number one on the *Billboard* 200 charts. *Contra* is a magnificent blend of pop and indie synths. Lead singer Ezra Koenig's witty and charming lyrics reflect the band's Ivy League schooling — on "I Think UR a Contra" Koenig sings of a privileged ex girlfriend: "you wanted good schools and friends with pools".

SPOTLIGHT: THE DOORS

In the 1960s counter culture movement few bands summed up the idea of "sex, drugs and rock 'n' roll" better than LA rock band The Doors. Frontman Jim Morrison's poetic lyrics were dark and hedonistic — the drug references in "Light My Fire" and the sexually charged rage of "The End" were highly controversial but also a key to their popularity. Morrison's debauched stage antics would make

crowds go wild — in one performance he was even arrested on stage. In 1971 Morrison died of an apparent overdose and 21 years after his death the band were inducted into the rock and roll hall of fame. We have five of the Doors' greatest albums on board.



GIN WIGMORE



Kiwi singer/songwriter Gin Wigmore describes her musical style as "like a mixed bag of lollies, there is a treat for everyone with my music, whether it be blues, rock, pop, folk or soul inspired."

And it's true. Her debut album *Holy Smoke* is a musically rich assortment which showcases the 23-year-old's diverse musical talents. The album is packed full of catchy numbers such as the rock 'n' roll foot-stomper "Oh My", the playfully girly "I Do" and sultry "Hey Ho", which Wigmore says is her favourite song to perform.

Holy Smoke was recorded at the world famous Capitol Studios in Los Angeles. "Going into work and walking past photos of Aretha Franklin and Frank Sinatra who have made

so many albums in that place kept me inspired throughout the recording process", says

Wigmore. The Cardinals (the former backup band for alt/country artist Ryan Adams) play with Gin on the album and give her songs a richness that complements her trademark raspy voice.

"I am finally comfortable with the crazy way my voice sounds. I love that people can identify my songs immediately due to my unique vocals," she says. "Funnily enough it also creates a real love or hate for my music from listeners, which is brilliant because I hate fence-sitters."
